If the vehicle is valued less than \$2,500.00 you are not required to file Electronic Export Information (EEI) through the Automated Export System (AES) as per 15 CFR30.37(a) vehicles valued greater than \$2,500.00, are required to file to file Electronic Export Information through the AES Failure to provide the required AES may result in penalties. This cover sheet and other required documents as per 19 CFR 192 must be presented to the **C**ustoms and **B**order **P**rotection export office a minimum of 3 days prior to exportation . The 3 days excludes the day of presentation, weekends and hollydays. Upon presentation to C.B.P. of the required documents, the conveyance must remain in the United States at the address listed below until presented to C.B.P. for legal export at the Otay Mesa Export Facility. Failure to do so may result in penalties as provided for in the Federal Code of Federal Regulations, 19 CFR 192.
